Because of your willingness to support our mission in 2022, more families are now able to live in safe, affordable homes throughout Northwest Vermont. **Your steadfast belief in the work we do** has helped to created diverse communities and neighborhoods, which means more hardworking, low-income Vermont families have realized their dream of owning their own homes.

Since 1984, Green Mountain Habitat for Humanity has partnered with families, community members, donors, foundations, and organizations. During that time, we are proud to have worked hard to meet the affordable housing and affordable homeownership crisis by building **112 new Habitat homes throughout Northwest Vermont**. And, with an average family of three living in a Habitat home, your support has helped over **336 low-income Vermonters** settle into a home of their own.

We tip our hats to the many volunteers and 27 local organizations who have helped us build our homes over the past year. Their belief in our mission and their dedication to our work has helped in immeasurable ways. We are grateful.

We are looking to the future and working hard to meet the critical affordable housing needs in our communities. Here are just some of the new homes and neighborhoods we'll be working on:

- Constructing homes for four of our partner families in Burlington
- Building new single-family homes in Colchester, Swanton, and Morrisville
- Collaborating on a new neighborhood in Hinesburg which will include 20 new Habitat homes.
- Breaking ground on a new Habitat community with seven homes n Underhill

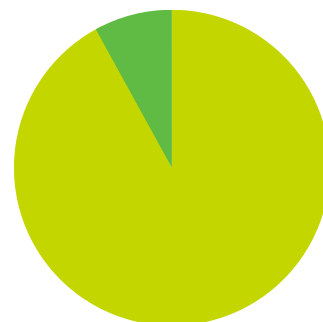
