Before Habitat, these families were living in substandard, unsafe, and overcrowded rentals and just making enough to cover their high housing costs. When they decided to make the move to home ownership, they gave hundreds of hours of their own time ("sweat equity") and worked alongside hundreds of volunteers, to make their dream of homeownership a reality.

We are proud of our partner families who purchased their Habitat homes at cost this year in Swanton, Morrisville, Burlington, Shelburne, and Colchester and are excited to work with our partner families who soon will be Habitat homeowners in Burlington, South Burlington, and Morrisville.

As we celebrate our 40th Anniversary this year, we look forward to continuing to work together in our community, building homes and hope throughout Northwest Vermont.
