# What is Women Build?



While fundraising is integral to achieving our mission, our events are not designed to center around raising money. The central purpose of our events is to bring people together to build homes for local low-income families and bring attention to the housing insecurities Vermont faces. We hope to speak to the varying housing needs of our community members and highlight how our work changes lives and can grow local community resilience.

Our Women Build Week is an annual event to raise awareness about the housing crisis and its disproportionate impact on women-led households. Teams are responsible for raising money to cover the cost of the day's building materials, site supervision, meals, and swag. On the next page you will see the Sponsorship Opportunities and what comes with each level. From Legacy Builders to Community Builders, these sponsors help us empower women on the build sites, year after year.

Our Home Builder Sponsor is a new addition with a peer-to-peer fundraising model. This sponsorship level gives individuals and smaller organizations the opportunity to become involved in Women Build. Those choosing the Home Builder Sponsor must raise at least \$100 per person to secure a spot.

Priding ourselves on being allies to all, we believe that a person is shaped by multiple overlapping identities, creating a reality greater than the sum of its parts. Gender, race, age, location, disability status, income, sexuality, and citizenship are a few of the many identities that shape our experiences and needs. We encourage self-identifying women, people of color, trans women, and women-aligned groups to participate.

Green Mountain Habitat for Humanity is a non-profit homebuilder that partners with donors, local families, and volunteers to build and sell affordable homes in Chittenden, Franklin, Grand Isle, and Lamoille counties. Habitat homebuyers help build their homes alongside community volunteers and pay an affordable mortgage. Green Mountain Habitat receives no funding from HFHI and raises all funds locally. Since its founding in 1984, the affiliate has built over 115 homes in the region and now operates three Habitat ReStores in Williston, Milton, and Swanton.



## Fast facts

- We sell the homes to the families at cost, and their mortgage is often less than what they were paying in rent!
- The partner families must agree to do 400 (for two adult households) or 200 (for one adult households) hours of work on their house, which is called 'Sweat Equity'
- We have over 50 projects in the pipeline!
